This month's tested recipe:

No-Fail Yorkshire Pudding A great accompaniment to any roast.

Put ungreased muffin tins into the oven, and turn to 400.
Have all ingredients at room temperature.
Mix 1 cup flour and ½ tsp salt
Use a whisk, and add ½ cup milk and mix
Add 2 beaten eggs and mix
Add ½ cup water and mix
Beat batter well until large bubbles rise to the surface.
Melt ½ cup butter, and pour into hot muffin tins, to about ¼ full. Add batter.
Bake for 20 minutes; reduce heat to 350 and continue to bake for 15 minutes or until very brown. Makes 6 - 8.
